Purpose: To learn how to use the video camcorder including power, white balance, focus, record and playback.

Assignment: Create a slideshow by recording 10 pictures to videotape for 10 seconds each.

Directions:

1. Prepare your tape by recording :30 of black with the lens cap on.
2. Set up camera on tripod.
3. White balance camera manually.
4. Tape first picture to whiteboard.
5. Point camera at picture,
6. Fill frame with picture leaving no white space on the sides.
7. Focus camera manually.
8. Record first picture for 10 seconds.
9. Record the other 9 pictures for 10 seconds each.
10. Record 10 seconds with lens cap on after the last picture.
11. Rewind slideshow and show Mr. Foster your project for a grade.

What to turn in:

1. Show me your video on the camera when you are finished.
2. Turn in this project sheet.

Grading Criteria:

1. 10 pictures in slideshow.
2. 10 seconds of each picture.
3. Each picture fills the entire video frame.
4. Video is properly white balanced.
5. Video is in focus.
6. Video finished and turned in on time.
7. Videotape prepared at the beginning.
8. 10 seconds of black after slideshow.
9. Tape must be rewound before showing project to Mr. Foster.
10. Keep camera movement to a minimum when starting and pausing recording.
